

Public Transportation Guide to Cape Muroto







Take the Dosan Line from JR Kochi Station to Nahari Station on the Tosa Kuroshio Railway.

The trip will take about 1hr 30mins. (The time may vary depending on how long it takes to transfer trains.)

^{*}The train will depart from platforms 1 to 4, depending on which time you depart. You can look up the timetable here: https://world.jorudan.co.jp/mln/

^{*}Change to the Tosa Kuroshio Gomen/Nahari Line (土佐くろしお鉄道ごめん・なはり線) at Gomen Station(後免駅).

^{*}If you catch the train heading directly to Nahari from Kochi, there is no need to transfer trains. (Trains heading directly to Nahari (奈半利) depart about once every hour.)





After passing through the ticket gates, head down the stairs. You'll find the bus stop at station square to the left. After arriving at Nahari Station, you'll need to transfer to a bus.



This is the sign for the Kochi Tobu Transport (高知東部交通) buses heading to either Muroto Geopark Center (室戸ジオパークセンター) and Kannoura (甲浦).

It takes about 1hr to reach the Cape Muroto (室戸岬) bus stop.

*One to two buses depart here per hour.

Alight at the Cape Muroto (室戸岬) bus stop.

After getting off the bus, start walking back in the direction you came from and head towards the bronze statue.

It takes about 5mins to walk to the Cape Muroto Lighthouse (室戸岬灯台) from the bus stop.

Head up the stairs located to the side of the statue.



Then you will have arrived at Cape Muroto Observatory (室戸岬展望台).
