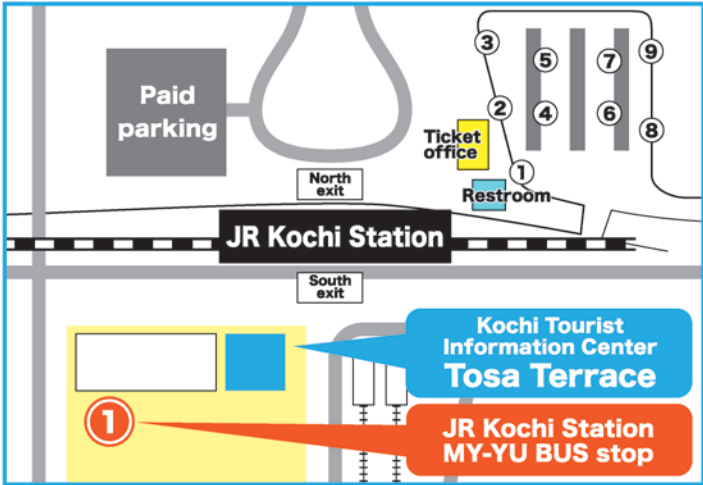

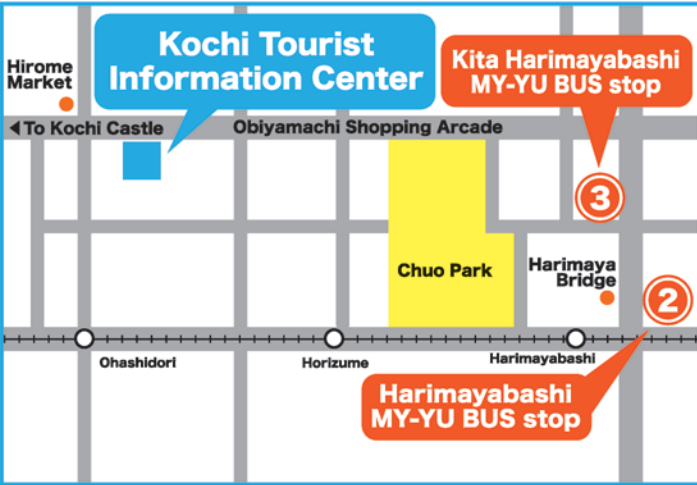

C Kochi Castle

The castle was built in 1601 by Katsutoyo Yamauchi, the first lord of the Tosa Domain. It is one of the existing 12 castles in Japan that still have a castle tower from the Edo period. 15 buildings, including Honmaru Palace and Ote-mon Gate, are designated as National Important Cultural Properties.
