B Ryoma's Birthplace Memorial Museum

D Kochi Castle Museum of History

E Sunday Market

One of the largest roadside booth stalls in Japan, with approx. 300 different booths opening every Sunday. A wide range of products, like specialty foods, famous Tosa-uchihamono cutting tools and many antiques are on sale. Well worth a visit.

F Hirome Market

This is a massive food stall village located at the site where there used to be a mansion owned by Hirome-shigeaki FUKAO who was a Karo (chief retainer) of the Tosa Domain. There are more than 60 shops including restaurants, izakaya (Japanese style pub), and souvenir shops, offering everything that is authentic and unique to Kochi.

G Harimaya Bridge

This bridge originated as a private access to link wealthy merchants who were situated facing each other across the river during the period of domain duties. The red, varnished arched bridge is a recommended site for taking photographs. The mechanical clock installed at the east side of the bridge is also an interesting feature.

H Yokoyama Memorial Manga Museum

There is also a conservatory displaying rare tropical plants and a "Tosa Kanran Center" that contains an arrangement of traditional garden plants. All of these varied and spectacular species are a must-see.



In the main building, hands-on exhibits will entertain visitors from small children to history buffs.

O Katsurahama Aquarium

Located at Katsurahama beach. Visitors can see the aquatic animals at close range here. Feeding and petting experiences are fully available. This is one of the rare aquarium that exhibits schooling "Akame" Japanese lanterns. The sea lion shows are very popular. A large variety of marine life is also on view at the aquarium.

P Statue of Sakamoto Ryoma

Sakamoto Ryoma promoted Japan's modernization with his high ideals at the end of the Edo period. The statue was created by Hakuun Motoyama, a sculptor from Kochi prefecture. The maximum overall height of the statue is 13.5m with his actual statue height of 5.3m.
